Workshops:

- 28th and 29th December, 2011: A two-day workshop on Continuous and Comprehensive Evaluation was organized to clarify the concept of CCE, and make the student-teachers & school teachers of the CBSE board aware of its importance. The workshop was conducted at the 'Conclave' in Dr. K.M. 'Vasudevan Pillai Campus, New Panvel, as a joint venture by the PCER- Panvel and the Mahatma CBSE schools at New Panvel and Rasayani. The resource persons for the workshop were; Mr. Pravin Zear, Vice Principal of B. K. Birla Centre for Education and their Administration officer, Mr. T. S. Nair.
- 27th January, 2012: A workshop on ' Jerk Technology' devised by Prof. D .N. Sansanwal, Head and Coordinator, Department of Education, Devi Ahilya University, Indore, was conducted by Asst. Prof. Mrs. Namrata Saxena. The various activities helped the student-teachers discover that the learners can be made active in the classroom through apt content related jerks, thus improving receptivity.
- 27th January, 2012: A workshop on "Environment Education through Innovative Classroom Teaching Methods" was conducted by a group of students, headed by Mrs. Tina Roy. The activities in the workshop succeeded in demonstrating the effective integration of Environmental Education with topics from different school subjects. All the participants agreed, that most of these activities could be conducted in any school, within the time

- constraint of 30 minute- class period, by any teacher with minimal resources.
- March 2012: To nurture creative instincts of the students, a workshop on SUPW was conducted. This was possible because of our very creative students. Ms.Chandni Halani showed how to make a chocolate bouquet with different coloured chocolates and candies. Mrs. Laxmi Ganiger demonstrated how to make a paper basket with old newspapers.. Ms. Raksha, Ms. Rakhi and Ms. Padma displayed how to make lovely flowers from kite paper and tissue papers. It was amazing to see how simple household things could be used to make such beautiful items.
- 3rd March, 2012: The PCER-Panvel Alumni association, under the auspices of the college, organized the Alumni meet on 3rd March, 2012, wherein a workshop on 'Time Management' was conducted. The resource person for this workshop was, Mrs. Simran Kasu, an experienced teachereducator. Along with the alumni, the current batch students also took the opportunity to attend this workshop.
