


1. When you joined college, were you oriented about expectation from you and the competencies you should develop on completion of the Programme?




- Both expectation and competencies were clearly stated


2. The Theory courses during B.Ed. / M.Ed. have helped you become aware of the way school system works in the country.




3. Availability of educational documents/ reports were a great help in understanding educational operations.




4. During your stay in college, you had exposure to multiple modes of teaching-learning in the classroom.















#### 8. You were appropriately "prepared" for the practice of teaching in schools.






## 10. How do you rate your experience in school during internship?




