Review planning of course subjects and activity portfolios w.r.t. Sem-4 for S.Y. B.Ed. & S.Y. M.Ed. students

- Syllabus completion Syllabus was completed on time and revision was conducted. Dwindling attendance was observed due to the student teachers being in their last semester.
- Research S.Y. M.Ed. student teachers submitted their dissertations on time and their viva was completed.
- Practice teaching The teacher educators faced the following issues like submission of lesson plans on time and cancellation of lessons. The teacher educators were also having issues of entering marks on time. So, it was decided that teacher educators must be firmer in collecting lesson plans and give timely reminders to the student teachers. Also, cancellation of lessons should only be allowed in case of genuine reasons.
- Examination Some students did not attend essay and class test and hence retest dates had to be allotted. Regarding assignments it was noticed that some students did not submit their assignments on time and hence necessary actions were taken.

<u>Conduct of Community work and Co-curricular activities</u>: This year, community work will be taken up at Special Schools. The schools identified are in Panvel. Permission must be sought and list of students to be submitted to the schools. Students need to be oriented on the take and nature of work at school must be explained to them.

For co-curricular activities, cultural diversity of India will be celebrated. Students will be oriented to the activity, grouped, assigned states of India, and given time to present cultural highlights of the allotted state.

<u>Internship of F.Y. B.Ed. Semester 2:</u> Student teachers must complete 4 weeks of internship during which 5 lessons in their first method has to be taken. Permission from the practice teaching schools must be sought, list of students to be submitted to the respective schools, student teachers must be assigned shadow teachers, lessons to be guided, supervised and feedback given.

<u>Main issue:</u> It was observed by the teacher educators that student-teachers have to be trained for better involvement of pupils in their classroom.

<u>Decision taken:</u> It was decided that the teachers & students should be trained for conducting experiential learning and Models of teaching though it is not a part of the curriculum. The students should link the real-life experience with the school subjects. Demonstrations of model lessons should be given by the teacher educators to equip the student teachers with skill of concept attainment model and inquiry training model. After the demonstrations presentation by

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students should be followed. The students should be provided with proper guidance and adequate feedback.

<u>Internship:</u> S.Y. B.Ed. will have internship programme of 11 weeks in the third semester and 4 weeks in the fourth semester. Permission from the practice teaching schools should be sought, list of students must be submitted to the schools. The students have to take 15 lessons during their third semester internship and 10 lessons during their fourth semester internship. All the lesson must be guided, supervised and constructive feedback given after the lesson. The students should attend schools as per the school timings.

Action Research: Student teachers have to conduct action research in their fourth semester. The teacher in charge will be Mrs. Pradnya Jadhav. Student teachers will be oriented, and a time line must be provided to them till the submission of the action research report. The student teachers will be grouped under different guides. Timely guidance has to be provided to the student teachers by their respective guides.

Other matters: Owing to the sudden lockdown due to Covid situations and the uncertainty of reopening, the lectures were immediately shifted online. After initial teething problems, the lectures were conducted smoothly. It was also decided that to improve the digital skills of teacher educators and student teachers, webinars on online teaching tools will be conducted.

Main Issue 1: It was observed that the learning resources submitted by student teachers faced the issue of storage space.

Action/ decision taken: The issue was discussed among the teacher educators, and it was decided that student teachers should generate ideas and implement it into making compact, workable, foldable and portable learning resources.

Main Issue 2: The student teachers requested more study-time in between their class tests for better preparation and performance in tests.

Action/ decision taken: The schedule of the B.Ed.& M.Ed. course starts very late and hence it was not possible to have gaps in the exam dates. However, study leave, though less, will always be made possible.

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
