At the state level the members include Home Secretary, associate members, deputy secretary. It carries out various projects and foresees their implementation on the state level. The organization includes Civil Defence Joint Planning Staff headed by the senior most IPS. At the state level, Mr. Sanjay Pandey is the Director. In the state of Maharashtra the organisation is present only in 5 districts towns because of the risk factors present there. These include Mumbai, Tarapur, Raigad, Nasik and Thane.
