Minutes of the IQAC meeting held on 15th July 2023

Discussion of Plan of Action for the year 2023-2024

Keeping in mind the objectives of the B.Ed programme, IQAC discussed about the plan of action for the year 2023-2024 wherein various academic as well as co-curricular activities which can be conducted were discussed. Principal Dr. Sally Enos told the committee members that in her meeting with the staff members the subjects and modules to be taught with respect to B.Ed. & M.Ed. were discussed and workload properly distributed.

Regarding alliance with other institutions

Dr. Jiji Sahaya informed the IQAC members that for the next academic year, permission from new schools like Shri Balaji International, New Horizon Public School, Radcliffe School & Empyrean School was sought for Internship so that the students get exposure to different boards and learn about its functioning. Dr. Sandeep Shinde proposed that since our college has introduced new schools for Internship, we must get a formal letter of alliance signed between the institutions for ease of placements, conduct of internships and also for other practice teaching related activities. Dr. Bhavna agreed to do the needful.

Regarding delay in IIQA approval from NAAC & Speeding up the process of compiling data for SSR

Dr. Bhavna Dave informed the IQAC members that the IIQA was submitted to NAAC on 29th March, 2023. Certain clarifications were sought for which necessary documents were uploaded. However, NAAC has still not declared approval of IIQA. The SSR uploads can begin only when approval is sought. She added that we need to speed up the process of scanning, merging & compressing the supporting documents required for different metrics of the SSR. She requested all faculty members to put in extra time & efforts in the process.

Discussion on Best practices & Institutional distinctiveness

Dr. Sally Enos informed the committee members that Community interface & Environment Consciousness continue to be our best practices as a lot of our activities are centered around these core-values. Community interface is our commitment to fostering strong bonds with the NGOs we have a Memorandum of Understanding with. It goes beyond mere engagement; it reflects a genuine

understanding of their needs, concerns, and aspirations. Our students gain valuable insights from these centers and in return ensure that our initiatives are relevant and impactful. This collaborative approach not only strengthens our relationships but also contributes to the development of the communities we are a part of. Simultaneously, our unwavering commitment to environment consciousness reflects through integrating eco-friendly practices. Our initiatives like making ecobricks, e-waste collection drive, making of compost etc. are designed with a keen awareness to reduce our ecological footprint & we continually seek innovative ways to minimize our impact on the environment.

It was then discussed that all curricular & extra-curricular activities help our students learn values of unconditional leadership & therefore the term 'SOUL' was coined by Principal Dr. Sally Enos to denote Service Oriented Unconditional Leadership to describe our Institutional distinctiveness. Everyone unanimously agreed to these practices of the institution.

The meeting ended by the vote of thanks proposed by Dr. Bhavna Dave.

Regarding Communication with NAAC awaiting pre-qualifier after DVV:

Dr. Bhavna Dave informed the committee members that issues were raised on the changes made by the DVV partner on 2nd Dec. 2023 with necessary documents. The response received to it was 'We will look into the matter on 11/12/2023.' However as there was no response since then, once again on 2/1/2024 & 20/1/2024 a request was sent to let us know about our pre-qualifying status. On 30th Jan. 2024, we received a response- 'As there was a technical glitch in opening some of the documents, it was requested that the concerned should open it for clarification. You might have received communication from NAAC in this regard. We will request them to expedite the matter. You may provide the correct data & supporting documents during that time.'
