Teaching Competency

To enhance the pedagogical skills of student teachers, PCER conducted teaching competency sessions in the first week of February 2024. The sessions provided comprehensive training in preteaching skills, covering a range of instructional techniques from lesson introductions to closures. Emphasis was placed on effective communication, voice modulation, and providing constructive feedback.



Key elements included aligning instructional objectives with core values and prior knowledge, as well as crafting effective lesson plans. This training equipped student teachers with essential skills to deliver engaging and impactful learning experiences tailored to diverse learners.



Experiential Learning: Role play: 2nd and 3rd February 2024
