

Extension Activity Report

Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension (DLLE) Activities

The Department of Lifelong Learning and Extension (DLLE) of Pillai College of Education and Research, Panvel actively organized and participated in various extension and awareness activities during the academic year 2025–26 under the guidance of Extension Work Teacher Ms. Bhanu Yadav. These activities aimed to develop social responsibility, leadership, civic awareness, and community engagement among students.



The DLLE activities commenced with the **First Term Training Program** held on 2nd August 2025 at Bhavna Trust Junior & Degree College of Commerce & Science, Chembur, Mumbai. The training was attended by the Extension Teacher In-Charge Ms. Bhanu Yadav and Student Manager Ms. Niyati Chavan. The program focused on enhancing leadership, coordination, and community engagement skills required for effective implementation of DLLE projects. Various resource persons guided participants about DLLE objectives, extension work projects, documentation procedures, community-based learning, and civic initiatives.

The session also highlighted the importance of maintaining 120 hours of extension work and encouraged students to participate in awareness programs, rallies, debates, and social outreach activities.
